

Hood River's Math Summit

This process was used by Hood River School District following the state adoption of the 2002 math standards. It is designed for alignment after adoption to learn standards and to find holes.

A "Math Summit" for Grades K-5 teachers was held to align the district adopted program, *Math Plus*, to the new 2002 standards.

A team of instructional leaders (one of each from grades Kindergarten to 5) led groups of grade level teams to go through *Math Plus* and look for "strong match," "okay match," or missing piece. Then each team brainstormed/shared supplemental resources to fill the holes.

Cluster Notes (Chapter/Unit) were written to help teachers really teach the material to really meet the state standards.

On the district H:drive (and each year when I teach new teachers) I make sure they have the notes and the supplemental materials.
